Guidelines for Admission to Masters' Degree (One Year programme)-Lateral Entry

1. The fee for the Master Degree (One Year) be as per the fee of first year PG programme as proposed by the departments concerned.
2. Admission Criteria:-The order of preference for admission shall be as follows:-
 - a) Order of Preference: Candidates who have obtained a Bachelor's Degree with Honours or Honours with Research from a recognized University/Institution.
 - b) Second Preference: A candidate possessing a Postgraduate Diploma in the concerned subject from a recognized University/Institution.
 - c) Preparation of Merit: The Merit list shall be prepared on the basis of final qualifying examination. The candidate must have passed all previous semesters and should not have any compartment, re-appear, backlog or withheld result in any paper of the qualifying examination. Admission granted under this provision shall remain purely provisional and shall be subject to the candidate producing proof of having passed the qualifying examination with the prescribed eligibility conditions on or before the date of issuance of admission notice by the University. Failure to do so shall result in the automatic cancellation of the provisional admission without any further notice.
 - d) Resolution of Tie: As per University Prospectus 2026-207.
 - e) Weightage as per Section-V of University Prospectus 2026-27.
3. Fee/Funds: As given in University Prospectus for first year of concerned PG programme. The processing fee i.e. Rs. 1000/- (Rs.250/- for SC/BC/Differently Abled of Haryana) per programme will be accepted through online (Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking) mode only. If a candidate intends to apply for more than one programme, he/she has to pay additional fee of Rs. 500/- (Rs. 125/- for SC/BC/Differently Abled of Haryana). The processing fee is non-refundable.
